Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs for the North Pike School District are located on the high school campus at the Career and Technical Center. Students can enroll in high school CTE programs during their 10th and 11th grade year. ICT I and ICT II are offered in 7th and 8th grade at North Pike Middle School. CTE programs are designed to provide students with academic and vocational skills to give them the advantages needed to compete for high demand and high wage jobs. The career and technical curriculum incorporates a combination of classroom instruction, exploration of careers, and hands-on-laboratory work. In addition, CTE students are encouraged to be active members in the student organization related to their CTE program.
